

Weatherization Laborer:

The Weatherization Laborer makes improvements to residences and commercial buildings for energy efficiency. The Weatherization Laborer works as part of a small crew that will perform one to four jobs each day at various locations in the Columbia Gorge including: The Dalles, Dufur, Hood River, Parkdale and White Salmon. The Weatherization Laborer will receive training in how to perform the functions of the job.

This is hard work in oftentimes dirty, confined spaces. However, we are looking for employees that want to commit to being part of our Weatherization Team and we are willing to increase compensation as an employee's level of commitment and performance increases.

Some of the duties include:

- Seal buildings and ducts for air leaks
- Install batt insulation or blow-in insulation in walls, floors and ceilings
- Install poly or other vapor barriers and weather stripping
- Complete prep work, including foam and caulk, filling joist spaces, etc.
- Load and unload equipment and materials
- Handle job site cleanup

Required Skills

- The Weatherization Laborer must be able to read and comprehend simple instructions and policies; fill out forms; and speak English clearly.
- A valid Oregon driver's license with a clean driving record is required.
- The ability to get along and work well with others is essential. The ideal candidate will speak both English and Spanish.

Other Requirements

- Must have a presentable, neat, well-groomed appearance
- Must be able to show up for work on-time and occasionally stay late if needed
- Must be able to lift 50 lbs, climb ladders, crawl under buildings, kneel, reach overhead and bend comfortably
- Must have high school equivalency or better
- Must provide 2-3 references

Schedule and Pay

This position is full-time with a 40-hour workweek consisting of 8-10 hour days. Pay rate will start at \$10 per hour and will increase with training and experience.
